The following is a registration form for any Lakefield Farms Trust (LFT) **property owner in good standing** who wants to keep a boat or other compatible watercraft at Lawrence Pond on LFT Clubhouse property at 21 Great Hills Road in Sandwich. Boat owners must **renew** their registration **every year** and stored boats **MUST** have a completed ownership sticker (Available from the Office Manager) attached to them. The boat owner is responsible to ensure that the information on the sticker is accurate and legible.

Note: *Compatible watercraft must be stored in one of the provided storage racks next to the tennis courts (Space permitting). Common-sense will dictate where watercraft that cannot fit into the racks must be stored. Watercraft must not be stored in the common areas or beach areas, or secured to any vegetation. Watercraft should be stored inverted to avoid being filled with water. Moored boats must remain clear of the boat ramp (See the Town of sandwich for mooring permits). After launching your watercraft, all vehicles must be parked in the parking lot (Not on the driveway). All watercraft must be removed from the premises from October 31 through March 31. Watercraft that are incorrectly stored may be removed and disposed of.*
